BDO was awarded the contract to complete the audit for Onions New Zealand in 2016 in line with Horticulture New Zealand and other vegetable product groups.

That the onions biosecurity levy remains at \$0/ha for year ended 30 November 2021.

Explanatory Note

Onions New Zealand consulted with members on the establishment of a biosecurity levy for response activities and submitted the application for the introduction of this levy in December 2017. The Biosecurity (Response—Onions) Levy came into force as of 1 November 2019. Year one of the Biosecurity levy was 1 November – 30 November 2019. Year two is 1 December 2019 – 30 November 2020. It should be noted that under the terms of the Biosecurity Act the Board has the power to vary/strike a levy within the year should an incursion occur.
